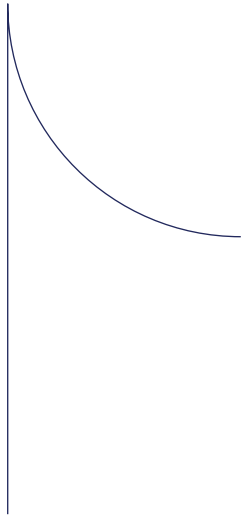


Preparing for a data breach
