EUDR postponement

- ➤ EC intends to postpone the application of the Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) once again. Already postponed once (its planned start date was the end of December 2024), the EUDR was supposed to come into effect on 30 December 2025.
- Now EC is proposing to postpone the application of the EUDR until 30 December 2026.
